Paint Your World with Light

The Mohawk Hudson Section of the Illuminating Engineering Society (IES) wishes to invite you to a presentation by guest speaker Janet Lennox Moyer, IALD

Jan Moyer, an internationally known lighting designer and recipient of many design awards lived & worked on the West Coast for nearly 20 years before moving back to the East Coast in 1997. She has judged lighting competitions, been published extensively including Forbes Life, Landscape Architect & Specifier News, and The Seattle Times. She has taught all over the world since serving as teaching assistant for her undergraduate lighting course at Michigan State University. Ms. Moyer's practice has included interior, commercial, and residential lighting, but her emphasis shifted to landscape lighting in 1983.

Ms. Lennox-Moyer shares the lighting issues necessary to consider for creating successful, cohesive luminous compositions. Jan will focus on the issues to think about when evaluating a site, during conceptual design planning, and specific issues to consider for plant materials. Jan will show day and night comparisons, the she will discuss how lighting planning needs to consider all the changes the garden will experience over time, and, as always, provide practical application information.

Jan is the author of the internationally acclaimed professional book on the subject of landscape lighting titled The Landscape Lighting Book, originally published in 1992 by John Wiley and Sons. The second edition released in March 2005 has three new chapters on documentation and garden evolution and an extensive drawing appendix.

Ms. Moyer will share how she visualizes an outdoor space to create a night environment. Ms. Moyer will address documentation issues and techniques showing examples of conceptual design imagery through working drawings into record documentation. Perhaps the most important issue Jan will cover is the need for and how to plan and implement an on-going maintenance strategy.

Jan is committed to sharing her knowledge and striving to raise the bar for the landscape lighting industry, as she would love everyone to be able to enjoy our planets' garden spaces after dark.
